

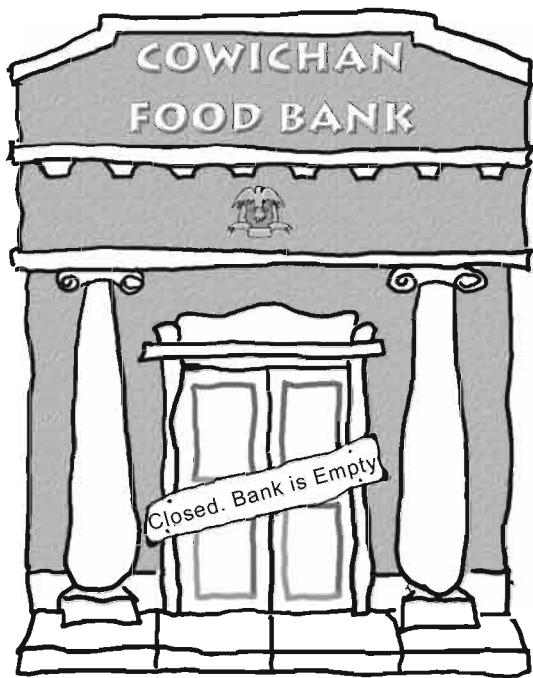
“Summer Still Hungry”
